**MOTION TO REOPEN CASE and
MOTION TO REINSTATE COMMISSION ORDER**

COMES NOW Complainant Denise Allegri (“Complainant”), by and through this *Motion to Reopen Case and Motion to Reinstate Commission Order*, and requests the Commission to reopen Case No. EC-2024-0015 and order Respondent ("Evergy") to reinstate its electronic filing of monthly status updates on its Fayetteville transmission line project, and in support thereof states as follows:

1. An informal complaint was filed by Complainant on July 26, 2026, requesting the Commission reopen this case ([EFIS Docket #150](#)) pursuant to its December 19, 2024 *Order Dismissing Complaints* ([EFIS Docket #139](#), <https://efis.psc.mo.gov/Case/FilingDisplay/608444>). This *Order* acknowledged the Commission's authority to determine whether a violation of CCN orders has been made, by stating:

"If and when Evergy moves forward with the Fayetteville Project, should any of the complainants allege, at that time, that Evergy has violated a statute, tariff, or Commission rule, decision, or order, they may file a new complaint with the Commission."

2. The Commission posted Complainant's informal complaint as a *Request to Reopen* on its electronic filing system ("EFIS") on July 27, 2026 ([EFIS Docket #150](#)).

3. As evidenced by Evergy's website and ongoing communications with MoDOT, its Fayetteville transmission line project is currently active, and according to its posted timeline, has remained active since the filing of the original complaint on July 25, 2023 ([EFIS Docket #1](#)).

MOTION TO REINSTATE COMMISSION ORDER

1. The Commission's May 9, 2024 *Order Directing Filing of Status Reports* ([EFIS Docket #117](#)) directed Evergy Missouri West to "file a report on the status of the Fayetteville Project plan and whether the plan has been shared with the Complainants" on the 15th day of each month. Since this project remains active, Complainants request the Commission either reinstate this order or make a new order directing the filing of monthly status reports until the project has been completed.

2. Throughout this project, Complainants have never received a copy of Evergy's complete and final engineering project plan. Final Commission orders regarding this case cannot be made without a completed project plan and an evidentiary hearing held on investigative findings. Complainants request the Commission direct Evergy to electronically file its completed engineering project plan, along with a list of impacted landowners involved in its project. If a completed plan is not yet available, Complainant requests Evergy to file a copy of its current plan under which it is operating, and if any future changes or updates are made, a copy of the revised plan to be filed along with its monthly status update.

WHEREFORE, Complainant requests the Commission issue an *Order* directing the reopening of Case No. EC-2024-0015; and directing Evergy to file on EFIS a monthly status report on its Fayetteville project, along with a list of impacted landowners, within 10 days of the order, and due no later than the 15th day of each month thereafter, including a current and/or complete and final engineering project plan or any revised project plan.
