ORDER CANCELLING CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Issue Date: August 26, 2026

Effective Date: September 5, 2026

On May 15, 2026, Netwolves Network Services, LLC (Netwolves) filed a letter notifying the Commission that it no longer wished to retain its certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri. Netwolves was granted its certificate of service authority in Case No. TA-92-190.

The letter stated that Netwolves does not provide any intrastate telecommunications services in the State of Missouri and that no customers will be impacted by the cancellation of its authority. Netwolves requested the cancellation be effective immediately. Netwolves has a currently effective tariff, Tracking No. YX-2011-0462.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-28.011(3) permits a company to cancel a certificate of service authority by filing a letter signed by a company official that identifies when and which certificate to cancel. Based on the request of Netwolves, the Commission finds that the certificate of service authority granted to it to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in Missouri shall be cancelled as well as its related tariff.

The Commission finds it reasonable to allow this order to become effective in less than 30 days.¹

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, granted to Netwolves Network Services, LLC in Case No. TA-92-190, is cancelled.
2. Netwolves Network Services, LLC's tariff, assigned Tracking No. YX-2011-0462, is cancelled.
3. This order shall become effective on September 5, 2026.
4. This case shall be closed on September 6, 2026.
