NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri (“Ameren Missouri”), and pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-10.165(3)(A)1., files this *Notice of Compliance* with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"). In support hereof, Ameren Missouri respectfully states as follows:

1. Section 386.756.9, RSMo, provides:

9. Any utility that directly or indirectly engages a utility contractor that may provide HVAC services shall develop a qualification process and make such process open to all utility contractors seeking to provide HVAC services. Utility contractors shall have the opportunity to register on the utility's vendor registration site and be evaluated for bid opportunities.

2. 20 CSR 4240-10.165(3) provides in part:

(3) Covered utilities shall develop a written qualification process for all utility contractors engaged in HVAC services and shall advertise bid opportunities to all such qualified contractors.

(A) The qualification process referred to above shall be established and in use no later than August 28, 2026.

1. Covered utilities shall file notification with the commission when they have achieved compliance with section 386.756, RSMo, including a detailed description of the qualification process.

2. The qualification process shall be posted on the covered utilities website accessible to any interested person or company.

3. Attached hereto as attachment A is the written process for Ameren Missouri's residential energy efficiency Pay As You Save (PAYS) and Single Family Income Eligible

programs. The attachment can be found on Ameren Missouri's website <https://www.ameren.com/partners/efficiency-contractor>.

4. Ameren Missouri does not solicit competitive bids for HVAC services under the BizSavers® Program. HVAC services are provided through an open Trade Ally Network established pursuant to Commission-approved tariffs and program rules. Ameren Missouri maintains a written, documented qualification process for HVAC contractors, as set forth in Sections 1 through 3 of the Ameren Missouri Trade Ally Network Terms & Conditions, which establish application requirements, eligibility standards, performance expectations, and quality control requirements. See Attachment B. Any HVAC contractor meeting these objective qualifications may participate as a Trade Ally. Because the program operates under a no-bid framework, contractor access is provided through non-exclusive enrollment and participation opportunities rather than bid solicitations. Information regarding Trade Ally enrollment and participation is publicly available on Ameren Missouri's website <https://www.ameren.com/business-solutions/efficiency/become-trade-ally> and is supported through standardized, non-exclusive program communications to ensure equal access for all eligible contractors.

WHEREFORE, Ameren Missouri files this *Notice of Compliance*.
