As you know from our telephone discussions, Kansas City Power & Light ("KCP&L") was personally served on December 14, 2009 with Missouri Public Service Commission Staff's ("Staff") Subpoena Duces Tecum issued on December 10, 2009 requesting production of a document dated December 7, 2005 regarding "Budget Proposal for Comprehensive Energy Plan Project" submitted to William H. 



In preparing this budget, Schiff has assumed the following as the general scope of our services in connection with the CEP Project:

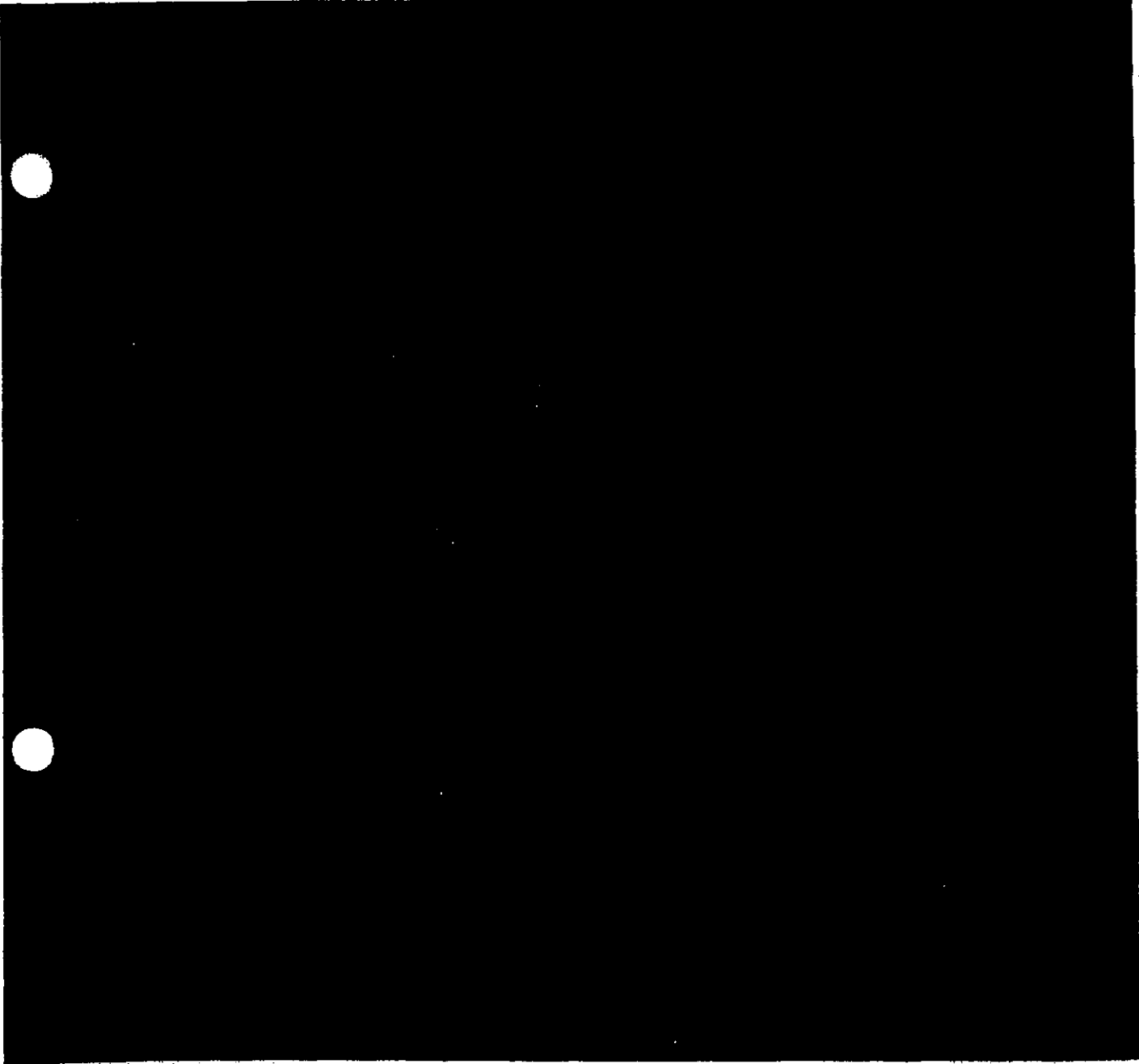

LaCygne 1 SCR

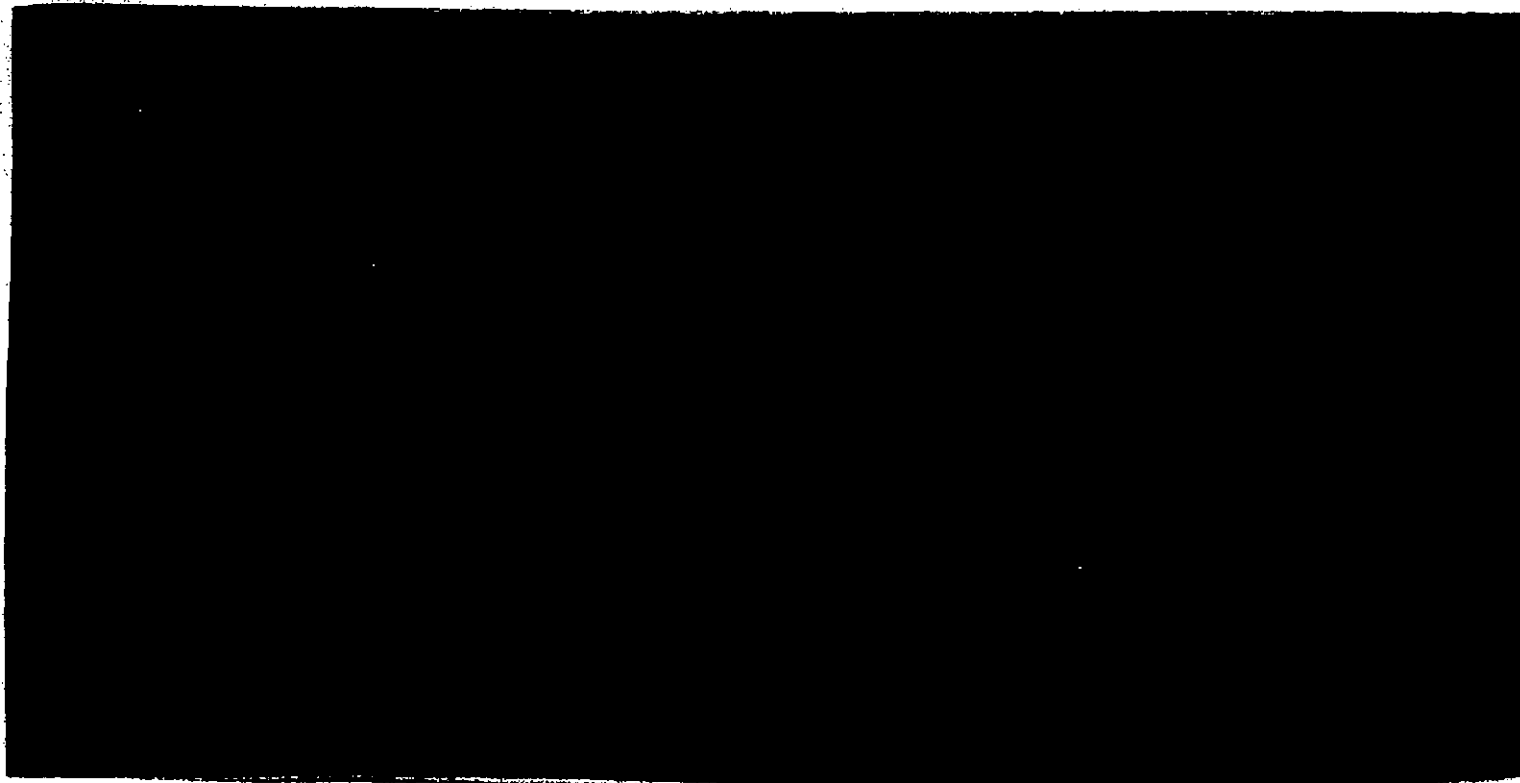
