NOTICE OF INTENDED RATE CASE FILING

COMES NOW Spire Missouri Inc. (“Spire Missouri” or “the Company”), on behalf of its operating units, Spire Missouri East (“Missouri East”) and Spire Missouri West (“Missouri West”) and, pursuant to Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-4.017(1), files this Notice of Intended Case Filing (“Notice”) with the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”), respectfully stating as follows:

1. Spire Missouri is a Missouri public utility and gas corporation with its principal office located at 700 Market Street, St. Louis, Missouri 63101. A certified copy of Spire Missouri’s Certificate of Good Standing was submitted in GF-2025-0053 and is incorporated by reference herein. Spire Missouri is a “gas corporation” and a “public utility” as those terms are defined in Section 386.020, RSMo., and is subject to the jurisdiction and supervision of the Commission, as provided by law. Spire Missouri is engaged in the business of distributing, transporting and providing natural gas service to customers in Missouri. In its eastern service territory, Spire Missouri provides gas service to the City of St. Louis and counties of St. Louis, St. Charles, Crawford, Jefferson, Franklin, Iron, St. Genevieve, St. Francois, Madison, and Butler. In its western service territory, Spire Missouri provides gas service to the counties of Barry, Barton, Bates, Carroll, Cass, Cedar, Christian, Clay, Clinton, Cooper, Dade, Dekalb, Greene, Henry, Howard, Jackson, Jasper, Johnson, Lafayette, Lawrence, McDonald, Moniteau, Newton, Pettis, Platte, Ray, Saline, Stone, and Vernon.

2. Spire Missouri prides itself on being a trusted energy company and community partner, focused on safely providing reliable and affordable natural gas service. Since its last rate case, Spire Missouri has continued to execute its capital investment plans to modernize and upgrade its infrastructure, improving reliability, and fueling economic growth and job creation.

3. Spire Missouri's rate case filing will include issues pertaining to a future test year, revenue requirement, class cost allocation, rate design, tariffs, and other matters commonly associated with a general rate case. The case filing will also seek to address issues related to revenue recovery impacts from weather and conservation. In Docket No. GU-2026-0225, a stipulation and agreement was reached involving the Company, Staff of the Commission, and the Office of the Public Counsel agreeing to meet ahead of the Company's rate case filing to collaborate on a solution to address the impacts of weather and conservation. The Company's filing will either contain the agreed upon solution, or Spire Missouri's proposal if no agreement is reached.

4. Spire Missouri has not engaged in any *ex parte* discussion regarding any substantive issue pertaining to this filing with the Office of the Commission (as defined in 20 CSR 4240-4.015(10)) within the 90 days immediately preceding the filing of this notice. Spire Missouri will submit its rate case filing between 60 to 180 days from the date of this request.

WHEREFORE, Spire Missouri respectfully requests that the Commission and its Secretary accept this Notice.
