ORDER GRANTING EXPEDITE REQUEST AND APPROVING COMPLIANCE TARIFF SHEET

Issue Date: September 3, 2026

Effective Date: September 7, 2026

On May 19, 2026, Spire Missouri Inc. d/b/a Spire filed an application to change its Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge (ISRS). On August 26, 2026, the Commission issued its *Order Approving Infrastructure System Replacement Surcharge* (Order) rejecting the previously filed tariff sheet and authorizing Spire to submit a tariff sheet in compliance with the Order.

On August 26, 2026, Spire filed a tariff sheet purported to be in compliance with the Order. The submitted tariff sheet carries an effective date of September 25, 2026, and was assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0029. Spire requested expedited treatment to permit the tariff sheet to become effective on September 7, 2026.

The Commission set a time for the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to file its recommendation and for other party's responses.

On September 1, 2026, Staff filed its expedited recommendation, which found the tariff sheet to be in compliance with the Order. Staff stated it did not oppose the request for

expedited treatment. No other party filed a response.

Upon reviewing the pleadings, the Commission finds Spire's tariff sheet complies with the Commission's Order and will approve it. To accommodate the unopposed request for expedited treatment, the Commission will make this order effective in less than 30 days and will approve the proposed tariff sheet to become effective on September 7, 2026.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Spire's request for expedited treatment is granted.
2. The proposed tariff sheet filed on August 26, 2026, and assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0029, is approved to become effective on September 7, 2026. The specific tariff sheet is as follows:

3. This order shall be effective on September 7, 2026.
