1 **I. INTRODUCTION**

2 **Q: Please state your name and business address.**

3 A: My name is Hsin Foo. My business address is 1200 Main Street, Kansas City,
4 Missouri 64105.

5 **Q: By whom and in what capacity are you employed?**

6 A: I am employed by Evergy Metro, Inc. and serve as Lead Quantitative Analyst-
7 Generation Resources for Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a as Evergy Missouri Metro
8 (“Evergy Missouri Metro,” “EMM,” or the “Company”), Evergy Missouri West,
9 Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (“Evergy Missouri West”), Evergy Metro, Inc.
10 d/b/a Evergy Kansas Metro (“Evergy Kansas Metro”), and Evergy Kansas Central,
11 Inc. and Evergy South, Inc., collectively d/b/a as Evergy Kansas Central (“Evergy
12 Kansas Central”) the operating utilities of Evergy, Inc. (“Evergy”).

13 **Q: Are you the same Hsin Foo who previously filed direct and rebuttal testimony**
14 **in this case?**

15 A: Yes.

16 **Q: What is the purpose of your testimony?**

17 A: The purpose of my true-up direct testimony is to address revisions made to the
18 Company’s production cost model that is used to estimate fuel expense, purchased

1 power expense and wholesale sales revenue. This testimony updates the
2 information provided in my direct testimony.

3 **Q: Please summarize the primary changes reflected in the true-up filing.**

4 A: The principal changes to the production cost model reflected in this true-up filing
5 include:

- 6 • Updated coal pricing used in the production cost model;
- 7 • Updated natural gas pricing used in the production cost model;
- 8 • Updated net system input requirements in the production cost model;

9 **II. PRODUCTION COST MODELING**

10 **Q: Has the Company's methodologies changed since the filing of your direct**
11 **testimony?**

12 A: No. The methodologies described in my direct testimony remain unchanged. The
13 updates presented in this testimony reflect replacement of estimated, normalized,
14 or annualized values with actual data, where available, through the true-up period.

15 **Q: What changes were made to the coal fuel costs used in the Company's**
16 **production cost model for the true-up filing?**

17 A: Coal prices for the Company's coal-fired generating stations in the production cost
18 model at true-up increased approximately between two-percent and seven-percent
19 relative to the assumptions reflected in direct testimony. The increase was primarily
20 attributable to higher diesel fuel surcharge costs associated with coal transportation.
21 These changes increased delivered coal costs and affected the dispatch of the
22 Company's coal-fired generating units in the production cost model during the true-
23 up period.

1 **Q: What changes were made to the natural gas fuel costs used in the Company’s**
2 **production cost model in the true-up filing?**

3 A: Average natural gas prices decreased relative to the assumptions reflected in direct
4 testimony by approximately six percent. Lower natural gas prices improved the
5 economic competitiveness of gas-fired generation and influenced the dispatch of
6 Evergy’s generating fleet within the Southwest Power Pool market.

7 **Q: What impact did these fuel market changes have on generation dispatch?**

8 A: The combination of higher coal costs and lower natural gas prices resulted in
9 reduced coal generation, increased natural gas generation and increased market
10 purchases compared to the assumptions reflected in the Company’s direct filing.
11 Lower natural gas prices also tend to reduce market prices because natural gas-fired
12 generation frequently influences Locational Marginal Prices (“LMP”). As market
13 prices decline, it can become more economic for the Company to purchase energy
14 from the market rather than dispatch higher-cost generating units. As a result, the
15 updated fuel and market price assumptions changed the economic dispatch of the
16 Company’s generation portfolio and the level of market purchases reflected in the
17 True-Up production cost model.

18 **Q: Were there any changes in load requirements reflected in the true-up filing?**

19 A: Yes. As discussed by Company witness Mr. Bass, net system input increased by
20 approximately three percent relative to the net system input in the Company’s
21 production cost model in direct filing.

22 **Q: How did these changes affect purchased power and wholesale sales?**

1 A: Higher net system input requirements, coupled with the changes in fuel and market
2 economics, resulted in increased purchased power and reduced the amount of
3 energy available for off-system sales compared to the Company's direct filing.

4 **Q: Does that conclude your testimony?**

5 A: Yes, it does.

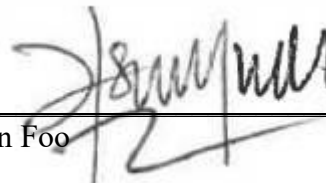
