1 **Q: Please state your name and business address.**

2 A: My name is Buck Reuter. My business address is 818 S. Kansas Avenue, Topeka,
3 Kansas.

4 **Q: By whom and in what capacity are you employed?**

5 A: I am employed by Evergy Kansas Central, Inc. and serve as Manager Regulatory
6 for Evergy Kansas Central, Inc. Missouri Metro (“Evergy Missouri Metro,”
7 “EMM,” or the “Company”), Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri
8 West (“Evergy Missouri West”), Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Kansas Metro
9 (“Evergy Kansas Metro”), and Evergy Kansas Central, Inc. and Evergy South, Inc.,
10 collectively d/b/a as Evergy Kansas Central (“Evergy Kansas Central”) the
11 operating utilities of Evergy, Inc. (“Evergy”).

12 **Q: Are you the same Buck Reuter who previously filed direct and rebuttal**
13 **testimony in this case?**

14 A: Yes.

15 **Q: Who are you testifying for?**

16 A: I am testifying on behalf of Evergy Missouri Metro.

17 **Q: What is the purpose of your testimony?**

18 A: The purpose of the Company's surrebuttal testimony is to respond to Staff's
19 position on CS-108 and explain the Company's proposed path forward. While the

1 Company agrees with Staff's recommendation to eliminate CS-108, Staff has
2 expressed concern that the adjustment was established through prior proceedings
3 in Case Nos. EO-2012-0367 and EA-2013-0098 and that the parties to those cases
4 should have an opportunity to be heard. The Company's surrebuttal
5 testimony explains its commitment to addressing that concern by pursuing an
6 amended stipulation in those dockets and providing the original parties, including
7 Staff, OPC, and MIEC, an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed
8 change.

9 **Q: How does the Company plan to address Staff's concern regarding the original**
10 **parties to the Transource cases?**

11 A: The Company recognizes Staff's concern that all parties to Case Nos. EO-2012-
12 0367 and EA-2013-0098 should have an opportunity to weigh in before the
13 adjustment is eliminated. If the Company files an amended stipulation in those
14 dockets all original parties, including Staff, OPC, and MIEC, will have an
15 opportunity to review and comment.

16 **Q: Does that conclude your testimony?**

17 A: Yes, it does.

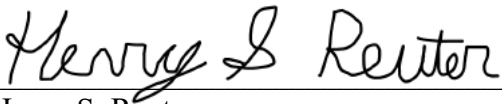

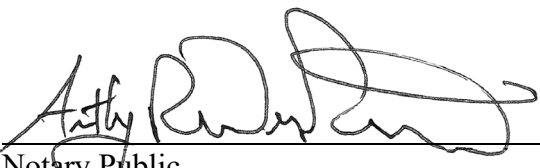
