**MISSOURI-AMERICAN WATER COMPANY'S
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO LATE FILE LEAD SERVICE LINE REPORT**

COMES NOW Missouri-American Water Company ("MAWC" or "Company") and files this Motion for Leave to Late File Lead Service Line Reports and states as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

1. As part of the Stipulations filed within this case, MAWC agreed to meet with the Staff of the Commission and the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") and to file a Lead Service Line Report (Report) bi-annually in this case that includes:
 - Known and estimated existing lead lines by source;
 - Lines replaced each reporting period filing as well as cumulative total lines replaced to date;
 - Location (zip code +4) and customer type of line replacement (e.g., residential, commercial, school, commercial, etc.);
 - Average cost, and breakdown by company and customer side, per district for each reporting period;
 - Nature and type of pipe replaced (e.g., lead, copper, galvanized gooseneck, etc.);
 - Water sampling results.
2. The Company has continued to track this information, create the Reports, and meet with Staff and OPC bi-annually, but since the October 2024 meeting the Company has been remiss in filing the Reports discussed during those meetings. Further, the next meeting with Staff and OPC is scheduled for October 2, 2026, and the Company will file the Report discussed at that meeting in the case as soon as practicable after that meeting.
3. Attached please find all of the Lead Service Line Reports that bring the Company fully into compliance with the Stipulation filed in this case.

WHEREFORE, MAWC respectfully requests that the Commission approve to accept these late-filed Lead Service Line Reports.

Water Quality Results

EPA'S Revised Lead & Copper Rule requires that utilities provide the customer with a Pitcher/Filter at time of replacement and sample 3-6 months later. To prepare for the future effective ruling date, Missouri American Water transitioned away from sampling at time of replacement on October 1, 2023. In addition, for the last 3 months, Missouri American Water has been ramping up the delivery of Pitcher/Filters and customers have responded positively.
