ORDER DENYING MOTION TO STRIKE AND DENYING MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUR-SURREBUTTAL TESTIMONY

On September 9, 2026, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its *Motion to Strike Portions of Surrebuttal Testimony of Geoff Marke, Ph.D., Alternative Motion for Leave to File Sur-Surrebuttal Testimony, and Motion for Expedited Treatment* (Motion).

On September 11, 2026, the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed its *Response to Motion to Strike Portions of Surrebuttal Testimony of Geoff Marke, Ph.D., Alternative Motion for Leave to File Sur-Surrebuttal Testimony, and Motion for Expedited Treatment* (Response).

In its Motion, Ameren Missouri argues that a portion of Dr. Marke’s surrebuttal testimony “is wholly new information that is not offered in response to any rebuttal testimony presented by any other party to this matter.”¹ In its Response, OPC argues that the portion of Dr. Marke’s surrebuttal testimony at issue is responsive to the Rebuttal Testimony of Jessica Polk Sentell filed on behalf of Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew

Missouri.² The Commission finds OPC's argument persuasive and, therefore, will deny the motion to strike portions of Dr. Marke's testimony.

Ameren Missouri's Motion, alternatively, seeks leave to file sur-surrebuttal Testimony if the Commission denies its motion to strike. The Commission finds that Dr. Marke's testimony was properly responsive to matters raised in Ms. Sentell's rebuttal testimony. Therefore, the Commission will deny Ameren Missouri's request for leave to file sur-surrebuttal Testimony on the issues cited in its Motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri's Motion to Strike Portions of Surrebuttal Testimony of Geoff Marke, Ph.D. is denied.
2. Ameren Missouri's Motion for Leave to File Sur-Surrebuttal Testimony is denied.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
