ORDER GRANTING APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE

On August 21, 2026, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively, Evergy) filed a joint application seeking Commission approval of certain demand-side programs, a Technical Resource Manual (TRM), an Evaluation Measurement and Valuation (EM&V) plan, and a Demand-Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) pursuant to the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA)¹ and the Commission's implementing regulations. The application and concurrently-filed documents comprise Evergy's MEEIA Cycle 5 filing.

The Commission set an intervention deadline and a deadline for objections to intervention requests. On September 4, 2026, Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) filed timely applications to intervene. No parties objected to either intervention request.

After considering the unopposed applications to intervene, the Commission finds that Renew Missouri and MECG have interests which are different from that of the general

public and allowing them to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3), the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene of Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri and Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) are granted.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
