ORDER APPROVING WEATHER NORMALIZATION ADJUSTMENT RIDER TARIFF SHEET

Issue Date: September 17, 2026

Effective Date: October 1, 2026

On September 1, 2026,¹ The Empire District Gas Company d/b/a Liberty (Empire) filed proposed revisions to its Weather Normalization Adjustment Rider (WNAR) tariff sheet in Tracking No. JG-2027-0033. The tariff sheet bears an October 1 effective date.

The purpose of the WNAR is to adjust revenues, either positive or negative, for differences between actual heating degree days and normal heating degree days. The WNAR is the measurement of the gas usage response of the residential customers to weather. The tariff sheet filed is a mandatory annual filing pursuant to Empire's WNAR tariff.

On September 11, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its recommendation. Staff reviewed the tariff sheet and corresponding workpapers and weather data, and recommended approval of the tariff sheet. Staff explained that, based on 100 Ccf² of natural gas usage in a given billing month, the WNAR adjustment would increase the average

monthly bill of the typical residential customer by approximately \$2.06. Small general service class customers using 100 Ccf of gas would see a monthly increase of approximately \$2.74.

The table below shows the proposed change in rates:

Class	Current WNAR Rate	Proposed WNAR Rate
Residential	\$0.01852/Ccf	\$0.03910/Ccf
Small General Service Sales	\$0.01756/Ccf	\$0.04500/Ccf

The Commission set a time for responses to the application or Staff's recommendation for approval.³ No party responded, and no party opposed approval of the tariff sheet. The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheet and Staff's Recommendation and Memorandum and finds that the tariff sheet should be approved. To allow the tariff sheet to become effective on the date requested, the Commission finds it reasonable that this order shall go into effect in less than 30 days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The following tariff sheet filed by Empire on September 1, 2026, and assigned Tracking No. JG-2027-0033 is approved to become effective on October 1, 2026:

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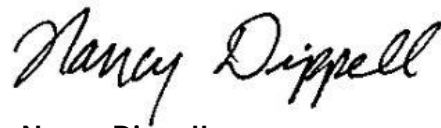
