FINDING OF NECESSITY AND ORDER DIRECTING PROPOSED RULES BE FILED FOR PUBLICATION

The Commission established this case to develop new integrated resource planning (IRP) rules for electrical corporations pursuant to Section 393.1900, RSMo. The new IRP rules were developed with stakeholder input in a Commission workshop case, Case No. EW-2026-0091, *In the Matter of a Working Case for the Development of Rules Regarding Integrated Resource Planning for Electrical Corporations as Required by Section 393.1900, RSMo*. Thus, the Commission proposes Chapter 21—Resource Planning for Electric Utilities. Specifically, the Commission is proposing the following rules:

- 20 CSR 4240-21.010 General Provisions;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.015 Electric Utility Resource Planning Definitions;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.020 Filing Schedule, Filing Requirements and the Integrated Resource Plan Proceeding;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.025 Standards and Dataset Management Requirements;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.030 Load Forecasting Requirements;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.035 Supply-Side Resource Analysis Requirements;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.040 Transmission and Distribution Analysis Requirements;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.050 Demand-Side Resource Analysis Requirements;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.055 Distributed Energy Resource Analysis Requirements;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.060 Alternative Resource Plan and Preferred Resource Plan Requirements;
- 20 CSR 4240-21.065 Implementation Plan Development and Reporting Requirements;

The Commission finds that proposing these rules is necessary to comply with the provisions of Section 393.1900, RSMo, to protect the public interest, and to carry out the purposes of the statutes that granted the Commission rulemaking authority. The Commission will seek comments from interested stakeholders during the rulemaking process.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Secretary of the Commission shall file the proposed rules with the Secretary of State for publication in the Missouri Register as a proposed rulemaking.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.

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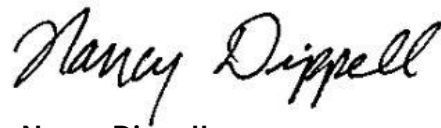
