**ORDER SCHEDULING A WORKSHOP MEETING
AND DIRECTING RESPONSE**

The Commission has established this working case to consider the potential impacts of current and future Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) rules on the reliability and cost of the electric generation plant operated by Missouri's electric utilities. On December 15, 2015, the Commission's Staff filed a motion asking the Commission to schedule a workshop meeting to address the cost of compliance with the EPA's Final Clean Power Plan Rule – Carbon Pollution Emission Guidelines for Existing Stationary Sources: Electric Utility Generating Units. Staff also asks the Commission to invite utility, industrial, consumer, and environmental stakeholder representatives to make presentations at the workshop meeting. Staff will be filing questions and scenarios in the next few weeks to assist those stakeholders in preparing their presentations.

The Commission will schedule the workshop meeting that Staff has requested.

1. A workshop meeting is scheduled for Thursday, February 4, 2016, starting at 10:00 a.m. and continuing until approximately 3:00 p.m. The workshop meeting will be held in the Ballroom (Conference Room 450) of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.
