ORDER SUSPENDING DOCKET

On September 18, 2026,¹ the Commission issued its *Order Granting Joint Motion for Consideration and Waiver of 20 CSR 4240-20.094(4)(H)* (Order) in this case. The Order included a directive to the parties to file a joint proposed procedural schedule no later than September 30, 2026.

Subsequently, on September 18, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively, Evergy) filed its *Motion for Suspension of Docket* (Motion). The Motion references a *Stipulation and Agreement*, also filed on September 18, in Case Nos. EO-2023-0369 and EO-2023-0370 that includes a provision that Evergy will request suspension of the docket in this case pending Commission action on the *Stipulation and Agreement*. Evergy states that no party objects to the Motion.

The Commission will grant the Motion and suspend the docket.

¹ Unless otherwise noted, all dates refer to the year 2026.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Evergy's Motion is granted. The docket in this case is suspended pending further orders by the Commission.
2. The parties are relieved of the obligation to file a joint proposed procedural schedule no later than September 30, 2026.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.

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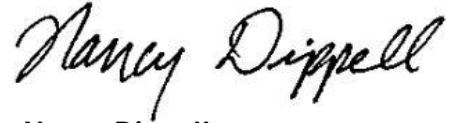
