ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE INFORMATION

On February 24, 2016, the Commission directed Missouri's investor-owned electric utilities to file information by April 4, 2016, comparing energy consumption patterns between customers using a budget billing plan and those not using such a plan. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, and The Empire District Electric Company filed timely responses on April 4, but Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed a Motion for Extension of Time, requesting an additional 30 days to compile and file the requested information.

The Commission will grant the Motion for Extension of Time.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company's Motion for Extension of Time is granted.

2. Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company shall file the information requested by the Commission in its February 24, 2016, Order Directing Response no later than May 4, 2016.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
