**ORDER ACCEPTING RESPONSE OUT OF TIME**

The Commission has directed its Staff to investigate whether rate-design mechanisms should be used to promote stability or growth of customer levels in geographic locations where existing infrastructure is underutilized. To assist Staff in that investigation, the Commission ordered Missouri's investor-owned electric utilities to provide certain background information by November 6, 2015. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri, failed to submit the background information on November 6, but filed the required information on November 9, along with a motion asking the Commission to accept the late-filed information out of time.

The Commission will grant Ameren Missouri's request.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Motion to Accept Response Out-of-Time is granted.
