Alstom (Lexa) told me yesterday that they bought winter jackets in August 2006 for KCPL folks but KCPL management told them that we were not allowed to wear them. Therefore they remain in storage. Brent told me that Mike C. has an issue with garments that have both KCPL and Alstom logos on the them. Is this the company position? Do you want to see a photo of the front of the jacket?
