**SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER REGARDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

On January 25, 2006, Aquila, Inc., applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission for a certificate of convenience and necessity for its already-built South Harper Facility and Peculiar Substation in Cass County, Missouri. After reviewing the parties' proposed procedural schedules, the Commission issued an Order Setting Procedural Schedule on March 15.

The Commission's March 15 order did not order the parties to file a list of witnesses or an order of cross-examination. The Commission will order the parties to file that information. In all other respects, the Commission's March 15 Order Setting Procedural Schedule remains in full force and effect.

**IT IS ORDERED THAT:**

1. The parties shall file a list of witnesses and an order of cross-examination no later than April 18, 2006.

2. This order shall become effective on April 13, 2006.
