On September 30, 2008, Aguila, Inc. d/b/a KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("Aquila") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission, pursuant to Section 393.170, 393.171, RSMo 2000, 24 CSR 240-2.060 and 4 CSR 240-3.105(1)(B) requesting that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CCN") for two facilities previously approved by the Commission; (a) the South Harper power plant and related infrastructure and (b) the Peculiar 345 kV substation recently annexed by the City of Peculiar, both of which are located in Cass County, Missouri.

Dogwood Energy, L.L.C., the County of Cass, Missouri, and the Sedalia Industrial Energy Users' Association all filed timely requests to intervene. The requests to intervene
