## **ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR RESPONSES**

Issue Date: November 20, 2014 Effective Date: November 20, 2014 On November 12, 2014, The Empire District Electric Company ("Empire") filed a Request for Scheduling of Public Hearings. Empire suggested three local public hearings be held the first week of February 2015. In response to Empire's request, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed *Comments and Recommendation Regarding Local Public Hearing Dates*. Staff proposes the local public hearings be held February 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> and the Technical Conference dates be re-set to February 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup>. The Commission will set a deadline for parties to file replies to Staff's requests.

In addition, on November 19, 2014, Empire filed a motion requesting leave to supplement the direct testimony of Todd W. Tarter and Dr. James H. Vander Weide. Empire states the supplemental testimony discusses issues related to the proposed continuation of its Fuel Adjustment Clause and Empire's cost of equity and a recommended range of equity. The Commission will set a deadline for responses to Empire's motion.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Parties may file responses to Staff's *Comments and Recommendation Regarding Local Public Hearing Dates* no later than November 25, 2014. 2. Parties may file responses to Empire's Motion for Leave to File Supplemental

Direct Testimony no later than December 1, 2014.
