ORDER AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On October 30, 2014, Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted a tariff designed to implement a general rate increase for electric utility service. The Commission established a procedural schedule for the case on December 12, 2014, which was amended on January 14, 2015 to include a deadline for requests for additional amendments. The procedural schedule provides for an evidentiary hearing beginning on June 15, 2015 and the filing of position statements by the parties on June 11, 2015. The Commission is concerned that this schedule provides insufficient time for the Commission to consider the positions statements of the parties before the evidentiary hearing begins. The Commission will move the filing date for position statements to resolve this problem, and will also move the deadline for filing surrebuttal testimony. In order to prevent complications from parties conducting discovery near the beginning of the hearing, the Commission will also establish a deadline for the conclusion of discovery.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The deadline for the filing of surrebuttal testimony is changed from June 5, 2015 to May 29, 2015.
2. The last day that parties may issue any discovery requests or conduct a deposition shall be June 5, 2015.
3. The deadline for parties to file position statements is changed from June 11, 2015 to June 8, 2015.
4. All other provisions of the existing procedural schedule, as amended, shall remain in effect.
5. This order shall be effective when issued.
