ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE OF FILING

Kansas City Power & Light Company (“KCP&L”) filed a tariff, to adjust its Demand Side Investment Mechanism Rider (“DSIM”),¹ bearing a proposed effective date of August 1. The Commission’s regulations provide that July 1 is the due date for Staff’s recommendation,² any notice of intent to participate,³ and any application for intervention.⁴ The Commission’s regulations also provide that any party to the action in which the Commission approved the DSIM is a party to this action and may file a notice of intention to participate, so the Commission will direct the addition of those persons to the service list for this action and will also direct notice as follows.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission’s Data Center shall add all parties from File No. EO-2014-0095 to the service list for this action.
2. The Commission’s Data Center shall serve a copy of this order on the county commission of each county in Kansas City Power & Light Company’s service territory.

3. The Commission's Public Information Officer shall make notice of this order available to the members of the Missouri General Assembly representing the residents of the service area of Kansas City Power & Light Company and to the news media serving the residents of the service territory of Kansas City Power & Light Company.

4. This order shall become effective when issued.
