In the November 17, 2003, issue of the Missouri Register, the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") published its proposed amendment to 4 CSR 240-18.010. The Commission proposes to adopt as its rule and incorporate by reference Parts 1, 2 and 3 and Sections 1, 2 and 9 of the 2002 edition of the National Electrical Safety Code.

Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE fully supports the adoption of the 2002 edition. It is vitally important—for the electric utilities, the public and the Commission—that the latest edition of the Code be in force.
