The Grain Belt Express Tiger Connector is an approximately 40-mile-long electric transmission line that will connect existing power infrastructure - the McCredie Substation, located in Gallaway County, Missouri - to new power delivery. This new power delivery is provided by the approved Grain Belt Express transmission line to be built in North Missouri. The proposed point of interconnection is in Monroe County, Missouri.

The Grain Belt Express Tiger Connector is one part of a vital infrastructure project built to meet the energy needs of Midwestern families and businesses by providing access to more affordable, reliable power. Tiger Connector will enable delivery of these benefits to more Missouri homes and businesses, by connecting the largest power grids that serve Missouri consumers.

Tiger Connector, an extension of the Grain Belt Express transmission project, will bring the economic and energy benefits of 100% homegrown energy to more of Missouri - lowering energy costs and improving reliability for more Missourians.
