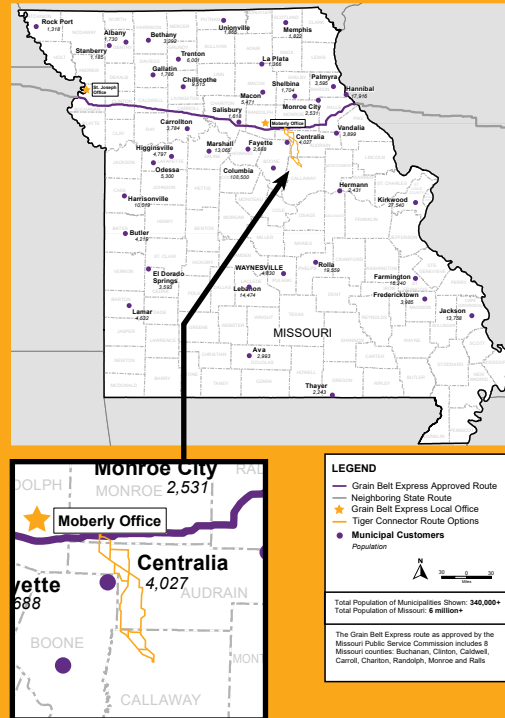


Why the Tiger Connector?

The Tiger Connector will enable Missouri to see an equal share of power delivered by the Grain Belt Express transmission, including delivery to 39 municipal utilities and access for rural communities, small towns, and cities across Missouri.

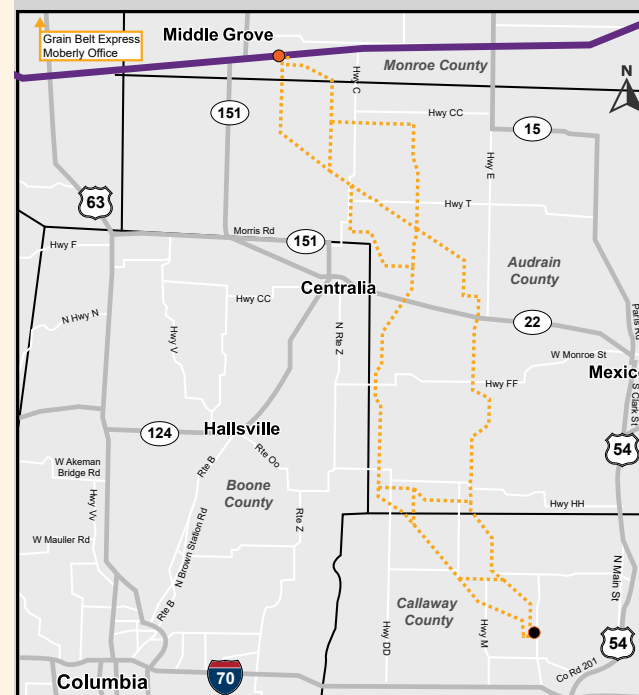
Tiger Connector Route Options

Routing Process

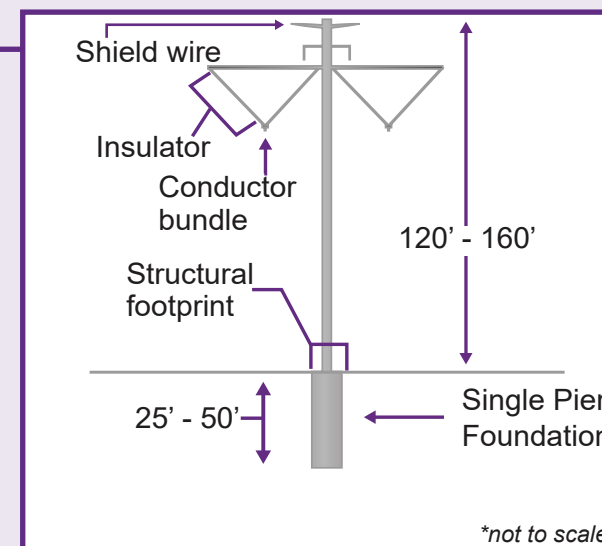
- A site has been selected and secured for a converter station in Monroe County.
- Power is transmitted across the Grain Belt Express using direct current (DC) and will need to be converted to alternating current (AC) at a converter station.
- Currently, there are a number of potential paths that Invenergy Transmission is evaluating. **There are no preferred paths to date.**
- Landowner input provides unique information that will help us make better decisions as we determine our proposed route for the Missouri Public Service Commission.
- All potential routes are evaluated by considering environmental, engineering, and social criteria. **All landowner input will be considered throughout the routing process.**

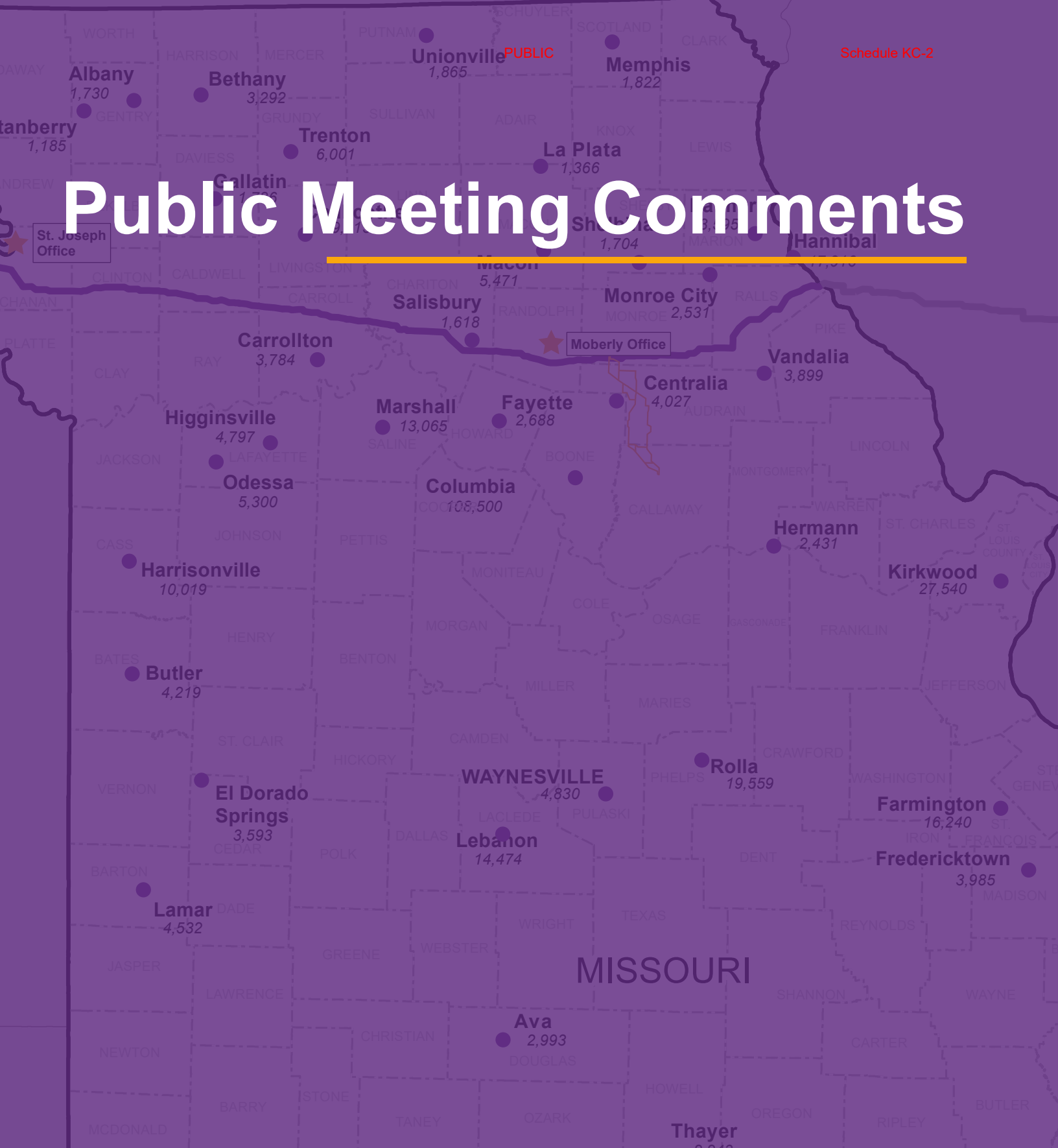

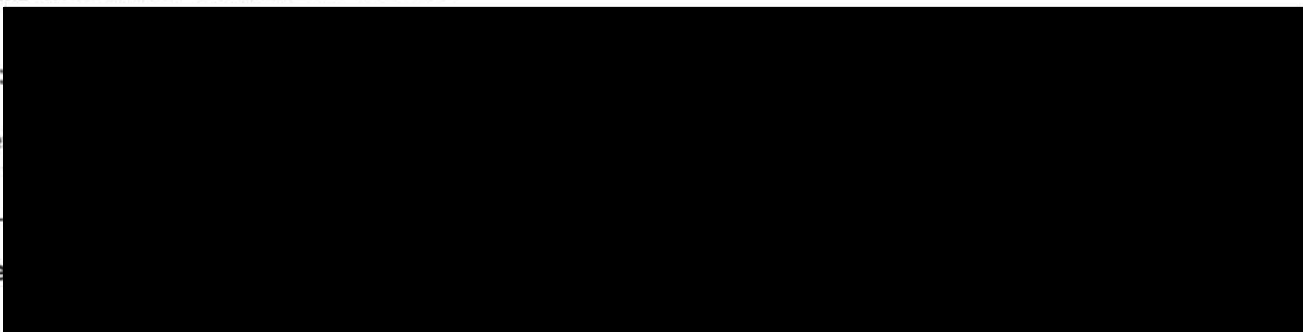

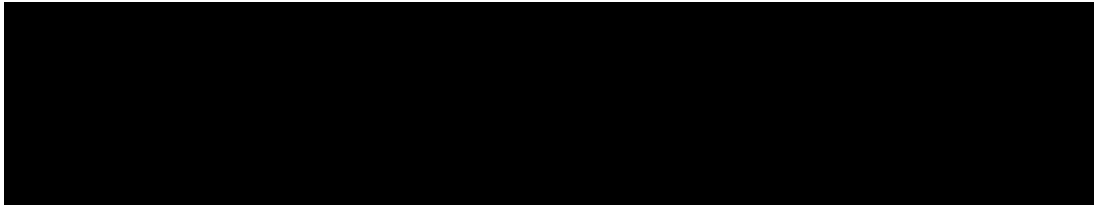

Tiger Connector developers whom it may concern,
Like many of our neighbors and friends, we were greatly dismayed to learn of the projected high voltage power line which will potentially cross our farmland and our own backyard. We are concerned with this project crossing our property for a multitude of reasons. As farmers, our livelihood is our land. This year, our irrigation system, which operates on one of the fields your electrical lines will potentially cross, has been instrumental in preventing severe drought damage to our crops. Every year, we depend on its operation for our crops' well being. With your proposed pathway through our farm, we will no longer be able to operate our irrigation pivot. Further, our newly built home, sits on on the irrigation lake and hosts a beautiful view. The electrical line is proposed to cross that lake and completely alter that view and devalue our land and home. We specifically picked this location for our home as an investment property with a plan to operate as a bed and breakfast in years to come and for

the ability to develop areas around the lake as homesites. Several sites have already been surveyed, cleared of trees, and have public water access in place. With the power lines crossing our land and lake, the draw of our property as a serene getaway will be lost, placement of future houses will be skewed or impossible, and interest from potential buyers profoundly impacted. With high voltage electrical lines and poles traversing our lake and land and impeding the views, our home and land would surely be devalued should we ever try to sell. This again affects both our daily and future livelihoods and ruins our chance of income from our investment. If able, we would invite you to visit our property in person to better visualize our concerns prior to making a final route decision. We hope you take serious consideration to our plight and urge you to please consider another pathway to reach your goals. Respectfully,
