1/ The FY 10 appropriation provides \$5.1 billion of which \$4.5 billion was allocated by a modified basic grant formula and \$598.6 million is provided in contingency funds.

2/ H.R. 3082, the fourth Continuing Resolution maintains funding through March 4, 2011 at the FY 2010 funding level of \$5.1 billion.

Under the terms of H.R. 3082, HHS has allowed states to spend at their normal drawdown rate of approximately \$3.9 billion through March 4. HHS has also released \$200 million in emergency funds under the provisions of H.R. 3082.

3/ FY 2011 allocation total includes \$3.52 million that was not initially allocated to tribal and territorial groups.
