ORDER SUSPENDING TRUE-UP TIMELINE

On April 1, 2011, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri submitted an application to the Commission containing its second fuel adjustment clause true-up filing, as it is required to do by Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-3.161 and 240-20.090. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D) requires the Commission's Staff to examine and analyze the information Ameren Missouri has submitted and to submit a recommendation to the Commission not later than 30 days after Ameren Missouri made its filing. Under that rule, the Commission must then act to approve, reject, or suspend Ameren Missouri's true-up filing by May 31. Staff filed its recommendation on April 26.

Staff's recommendation explains that this second true-up filing shares an issue currently pending before the Commission in file number ER-2010-0274, the case established to consider Ameren Missouri's first true-up filing. That issue, which concerns the possible correction of an error in Ameren Missouri's tariff, has been presented to the Commission for decision on stipulated facts. Ameren Missouri's reply brief is to be submitted in that case on May 20 and the Commission will decide the case sometime thereafter. Staff recommends the Commission wait to resolve this second true-up filing in a manner consistent with its resolution of the first true-up filing.

Staff is correct; the Commission cannot resolve this second true-up filing until the first true-up filing is resolved. The timeline in the first true-up filing case has been suspended until June 30, 2011. The Commission will suspend the timeline for this case to match that of the first true-up filing.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Pursuant to Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D), the timeline of the second true-up is suspended from May 31, 2011, until June 30, 2011.
2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
