- 1. On May 25, 2012, the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel" or "OPC") and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG") filed their *Motion to Strike Pre-Filed Testimony and Reject Tariffs of Kansas City Power & Light Company* ("KCPL") and *Motion for Expedited Treatment* in this case.
- 2. The Commission issued its *Order Granting Expedited Treatment As*To Response on May 29, 2012, which indicated that KCPL shall, and any other party
 may, file a response to the motion no later than June 15, 2012.
- 3. In addition to the continued heavy press of other Commission matters, a significant member of the technical Staff with expertise on fuel and purchase power recovery mechanisms is out of the United States this week on NARUC/USAID business. Although the Staff thought that it could work around this individual's absence from the Commission's offices, such a belief has not proved to be the case.
