**ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE, SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE  
AND DIRECTING STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

On March 22, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri"), submitted an application containing its ninth true-up filing for its Fuel Adjustment Clause ("FAC"). Ameren Missouri requests that the Commission authorize a true-up adjustment and implement it under its FAC tariff for the recovery period ending January, 2013. The submitted tariff bears an effective date of May 24, 2013.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5), the Commission's Staff shall submit a recommendation regarding the proposed true-up no later than 30 days after it's filing. No later than 60 days after receiving the proposed true-up, the Commission must: (1) issue an order deciding the true-up; or (2) suspend the timeline of the true-up to receive additional evidence or hold a hearing, if required. Consequently, the Commission shall issue notice, set an intervention deadline, and direct its Staff to file a recommendation.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.161(10) provides that parties to the rate case in which the Commission established Ameren Missouri's fuel adjustment clause are automatically parties to this tariff case, without the necessity of having to apply for intervention. Therefore, the Commission acknowledges that the parties to File No. ER-2008-0318 (the file in which Ameren Missouri's Rider FAC was first approved) are

parties to this case, and will direct its Data Center to add those parties to the service list. The Data Center will also be directed to send notice of this order to the parties in File Nos. ER-2010-0036, ER-2011-0028 and ER-2012-0166 (the files in which Ameren Missouri's initial Rider FAC was reauthorized with modifications).

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Commission's Data Center shall serve a copy of this order upon the parties to File Nos. ER-2008-0318, ER-2010-0036, ER-2011-0028 and ER-2012-0166.

2. The Commission's Data Center shall add all parties to File Nos. ER-2008-0318, ER-2010-0036, ER-2011-0028 and ER-2012-0166 to the service list for this case.

3. Any person or entity wishing to intervene shall file an application to intervene no later than April 5, 2013, with:

4. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall, no later than April 19, 2013, file a recommendation regarding its examination and analysis of Ameren Missouri's application.

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
