No responses to these applications have been filed. The Commission finds that the applications meet the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.075 and therefore grants them.

James P. Zakoura filed a petition for leave to appear *pro hac vice* on behalf of the Hospital Intervenors. Mr. Zakoura, an attorney not admitted to practice before Missouri courts, is admitted to practice before the courts of the state of Kansas. He certifies that he is a member of the Kansas Bar in good standing and is not under suspension or disbarment by any Kansas court. Further, Mr. Zakoura designates Neil S. Sader, Esq., a member in good standing of the Missouri Bar, as local representation. A receipt indicating payment

of the fees required by Missouri Supreme Court Rule 6.01(m) is attached to the petition, and Mr. Sader has filed his entry of appearance.

The Commission finds that Mr. Zakoura's petition complies with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) and with Missouri Supreme Court rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. He is granted leave to appear on behalf of the Hospital Intervenors.
