The Commission finds that Mr. Zakoura's petition complies with the requirements of 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C) and with Missouri Supreme Court rules 6.01(m) and 9.03. He is granted leave to appear on behalf of the Hospital Intervenors.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The applications to intervene of the following parties are granted: City of Lee's Summit, Missouri; Lee's Summit Medical Center, Liberty Hospital, Research Belton Hospital, Saint Luke's East – Lee's Summit, St. Mary's Medical Center, Saint Luke's Northland Hospital – Smithville Campus, and North Kansas City Hospital; Missouri Gas Energy, a division of Southern Union Company; Robert Wagner; AARP; Consumers Council of Missouri; The Empire District Electric Company, Missouri Retailers Association, Missouri Department of Natural Resources, and the City of St. Joseph, Missouri.
2. James P. Zakoura is granted leave to appear on behalf of the Hospital Intervenors.
