CLEAN Future Act – PURPA Impacts



- Establishes a standard under PURPA that electric utilities consider implementation of non-wires solutions, or alternatives to traditional transmission infrastructure, when appropriate.
- Provides that costs be recovered in the same manner as transmission upgrades;
- Establishes a standard for electric utilities to consider implementation of non-wires solutions, or alternatives to traditional transmission infrastructure, when appropriate;
- Ensures QFs have the option to enter a fixed price contract (for energy);
- Establishes a standard that electric utilities offer a community solar program to all ratepayers;

CLEAN Future Act – PURPA Impacts



- Reauthorizes, updates, and increases FY funding for rural and remote community electrification grants in Section 609:
 - Expand to include Indian tribes;
 - Increase the size of a rural area from 10,000 to 20,000 inhabitants;
 - o Expand grant eligibility to areas impacted by the closure of a coal generating unit
- Amends section 111(d) to:
 - Require states to consider authorizing measures encouraging deployment of electric vehicle charging stations;
 - Allow utilities to recover from ratepayers' investments that further deployment of electric vehicle charging networks; and
 - Exclude from regulation as electric utilities entities selling electricity to the public solely through electric vehicle chargers
