An information / question and answer session moderated by the Staff of the Public Service Commission will begin at 5:30 p.m. The local public hearing and the taking of sworn testimony will follow the information / question and answer session. .
2. The local public hearing will be held in a facility that meets the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. 5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
