The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Motion for Leave* to File Late Testimony ("motion").1

In the motion, the Department of Natural Resources ("DNR") asks to file the Direct Testimony of Adam Bickford one day out of time. That motion is subject to the following standard:

> (3) When an act is required or allowed to be done by order or rule of the commission at or within a specified time, the commission may—

(B) After the expiration of the specified period, permit the act to be done where the failure to act was the result of excusable neglect or for other good cause shown. [2]

Good cause means a good faith request for reasonable relief.³ DNR states that the one-day delay was due to the sudden illness of counsel. That circumstance shows good cause.

Therefore, the Commission will grant the motion.
