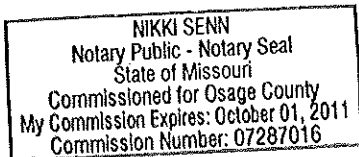

2 Q. In your rebuttal testimony you stated that you recommend full recovery of the
3 cost associated with ERPP as requested, did you not?

4 A. Yes.

5 Q. How do you wish to clarify your answer regarding full recovery of the cost
6 associated with ERPP?

7 A. I was, and still am, recommending full recovery of the ERPP cost; however, I
8 was not, and am not, recommending how that cost is to be recovered. Given that I am not an
9 accountant and that I am unfamiliar with the accounting treatment for full recovery the
10 Company proposed, I defer to the recommendation of Staff witness Bret Prenger, an
11 accountant, for how KCPL should recover the cost of the ERPP from its Missouri customers.
