Re: Construction Permit Application, Proposed Ameren Missouri Labadie Energy Center Utility Waste Landfill, Franklin County

Dear Ms. Fitch:

On behalf of Ameren Missouri, enclosed please find one (1) original and four (4) copies of Ameren Missouri's *Construction Permit Application (CPA) Labadie Energy Center Utility Waste Landfill* dated November 2013, along with related plan sheets and requested application fee of two thousand dollars (\$2,000). Upon timely approval of the CPA and issuance of a construction permit by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR's) Solid Waste Management Program, Ameren Missouri intends to construct a utility waste landfill at its Labadie Energy Center in Franklin County, Missouri.

The enclosed CPA conforms in all material requests with Ameren Missouri's prior permit application dated January 29, 2013 and amended February 7, 2013, and revised August 6, 2013. This prior permit application was withdrawn on October 27, 2013 to reflect additional groundwater monitoring wells requested by Franklin County and this submittal reflects those additional monitoring well locations.

By separate letter, Franklin County (the "County") will confirm, as it has previously, that the UWL design reflected in the CPA conforms to all applicable local planning and zoning requirements. It is our understanding that Franklin County will also provide to MDNR, Ameren Missouri's November 18, 2013 responses to comments of the County's Independent Registered Engineer. (The CPA has been revised to incorporate, as applicable, certain of such responses.) Lastly, as previously indicated by MDNR, we understand that your staff will expedite review of this revised and resubmitted CPA with the primary focus on the new or revised components of the application, while reviewing other application components primarily to verify that such elements have not changed. So as to facilitate that process, Ameren Missouri has met with your staff to review the CPA prior to its filing.
