## ORDER CORRECTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE NUNC PRO TUNC

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Issue Date: August 26, 2021 Effective Date: August 26, 2021 The Commission issued an order on June 9, 2021 setting a procedural schedule for this case. On August 26, 2021, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri and the Staff of the Commission filed a joint motion asking the Commission to correct an error in its order setting a procedural schedule.

The motion explains that the Commission's order contains a footnote 1 that indicates direct testimony proposing substantive changes to the costs or revenues to be included in the FAC, substantive changes in its operation (e.g. sharing percentage, number of adjustments), and testimony opposing its continuation is to be included with Class Cost of Service testimony to be filed on September 17, 2021. The motion further explains that in the procedural schedule proposed by the parties, that footnote instead referred to the filing of direct testimony regarding the company's revenue requirement to be filed on September 3, 2021. The motion suggests that the Commission inadvertently attached the footnote to the wrong provision of the procedural schedule and that the procedural schedule order should be corrected *nunc pro tunc*.

The motion is correct. Footnote 1 inadvertently refers to the wrong round of direct testimony. It should refer to the filing of direct testimony regarding the company's revenue

requirement to be filed on September 3, 2021, as it did in the procedural schedule proposed by the parties. The Commission's order will be corrected accordingly.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Order Setting Procedural Schedule and Adopting Test Year issued on June 9, 2021, is corrected *nunc pro tunc* to provide that direct testimony proposing substantive changes to the costs or revenues to be included in the FAC, substantive changes in its operation (e.g. sharing percentage, number of adjustments), and testimony opposing its continuation is to be included with direct testimony regarding the company's revenue requirement to be filed on September 3, 2021.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
