**ORDER APPROVING DEMAND SIDE INVESTMENT MECHANISM
RIDER RATE ADJUSTMENT TARIFF**

Issue Date: July 21, 2022

Effective Date: August 1, 2022

On June 1, 2022, Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West filed a tariff sheet, with supporting testimony, to adjust charges related to its approved Demand Side Investment Mechanism (DSIM) Rider under the Missouri Energy Efficiency Investment Act (MEEIA). The tariff sheet filing was assigned Tracking No. JE-2022-0267, and carries an effective date of August 1, 2022.

The Commission issued notice of the filing, set an intervention deadline, and directed the Staff of the Commission (Staff) to submit a recommendation. On June 30, 2022, Staff recommended the Commission approve Evergy Missouri West's tariff sheet. Commission rules allow responses to be filed within ten days.¹ No responses or objections were received to either Evergy Missouri West's filing or Staff's recommendation.

Commission Rules 20 CSR 4240-20.093(4) and 20 CSR 4240-3.162(8) require Evergy Missouri West to make adjustments of its DSIM rates to reflect the amount of

revenue that has been over- or under-collected. The proposed tariff sheet decreases the current residential DSIM Rider rate from \$0.00630 per kWh to \$0.00399 per kWh for residential customers. For a residential customer using 1,000 kWhs, this change will decrease the customer's bill by \$2.31 per month.

Non-residential customer impacts would be as follows:

Small General Service from \$0.00445 per kWh to \$0.00517;

Large General Service from \$0.00627 per kWh to \$0.00603; and

Large Power Service from \$0.00390 per kWh to \$0.00367.

For a non-residential customer using 1,000 kWh monthly, this would result in the following monthly billing changes:

Small General Service, a \$0.72 increase;

Large General Service, a \$0.24 decrease; and

Large Power Service, a \$0.23 decrease.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.093(4), regarding adjustment of DSIM rates between general rate proceedings, states that if the proposed adjustments are in accordance with the rule, Section 393.1075, RSMo, and the previously-approved DSIM, the Commission shall issue an order approving the tariff within sixty days after the tariff is filed. The Commission has reviewed Evergy Missouri West's tariff sheet, Staff's recommendation and accompanying memorandum, and finds that the proposed tariff sheet implementing the DSIM rate adjustment is in compliance with Evergy Missouri West's existing DSIM tariff and with all applicable statutes and regulations.

So that the tariff sheet will be effective at the time requested, this order will be effective in less than thirty days.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Every Missouri West's tariff sheet, assigned Tracking No. JE-2022-0267, is approved to be effective August 1, 2022. The tariff sheet approved is:
