Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff on August 1, 2022, to increase its rates for electric service. Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) filed an application to intervene on August 15, 2022. Renew Missouri Advocates d/b/a Renew Missouri (Renew Missouri) applied to intervene on August 19, 2022. More than ten days have passed since MIEC and Renew Missouri applied to intervene and no party has responded to either application.¹

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.075(3) provides that the Commission may grant a motion to intervene if it finds that the proposed intervenor has an interest that differs from that of the general public and that may be adversely affected by the final order arising from the case, or if granting the proposed intervention would serve the public interest. The Commission finds that allowing MIEC and Renew Missouri to participate in this rate case will serve the public interest. The Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. MIEC's application to intervene is granted.
- 2. Renew Missouri's application to intervene is granted.
