ORDER DIRECTING NOTICE AND SETTING DEADLINES FOR INTERVENTION APPLICATIONS AND STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION

Issue Date: October 4, 2022 Effective Date: October 4, 2022

On September 30, 2022, The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty (Liberty) submitted direct testimony and a revised tariff sheet proposing a revised fuel adjustment rate and bearing an effective date of December 1. Also on September 30, Liberty initiated a rate adjustment true-up, to be included in the proposed fuel adjustment rate.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-20.090 provides a 60-day timeline for resolution of these rate adjustment mechanism proceedings. The Commission will direct notice be given and set a deadline for intervention applications. The Commission will also direct Staff to file recommendations in both cases, as required by 20 CSR 4240-20.090.

Parties to Liberty's most recent general rate proceeding in which the Commission established, continued, or modified the electric utility's rate adjustment mechanism are automatically parties to these proceedings without application for intervention, pursuant to 20 CSR 4240-20.090(17). Thus, the parties to File No. ER-2021-0312 are parties to these cases.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. The Commission's data center shall add the parties to File No. ER-2021-0312 to the service list for these cases, and shall provide a copy of this order to those parties.
- 2. The Commission's data center shall provide notice of this order to the county commissions for each county in Liberty's service territory.
- 3. The Commission's Public Policy and Outreach Department shall provide notice of this order to news media serving residents in Liberty's service territory and members of the General Assembly representing residents in Liberty's service territory.
 - 4. Applications for intervention shall be filed no later than October 15.
- 5. No later than October 31,¹ the Staff of the Commission shall file recommendations reporting Staff's examination and analysis of Liberty's application and tariff sheet in these two cases, as provided by 20 CSR 4240-20.090(8) and (9).
- 6. Any response to Liberty's proposed fuel adjustment rate and/or proposed true-up amount from the Office of the Public Counsel and other parties shall be filed no later than November 10, 2022, as provided by 20 CSR 4240-20.090(8) and (9).
 - 7. This order shall be effective when issued.
