In the matter of Union Electric Company of St. Louis, Missouri, for authority to file revised tariffs for incandescent lighting service provided to customers in the Missouri service area of the company.

#### SECOND SUSPENSION CENER

On December 26, 1979, Union Electric Company of St. Louis, Missouri, submitted to this Commission revised tariffs limiting maintenance on private and municipal incandescent lighting for electric service provided to contains the Missouri service area of the Company. The proposed tariffs had a requested effective date of January 28, 1980.

By Order dated January 25, 1980, the Commission suspended said proposed tariffs for a period of 120 days, until May 27, 1980.
