AMENDED APPLICATION

Applicant hereby applies for Certificates of Service Authority to provide and resell interexchange private line and nonswitched local telecommunications services within the state of Missouri, requests competitive classifications for interexchange private line and nonswitched local services, and requests the standard waivers of statutes and rules. In support of this Application, Applicant states the following:

1. Applicant is a Missouri corporation presently certificated to provide local and exchange access services within its certificated areas within the State of Missouri. Applicant is a for profit business corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri. Applicant is authorized to do business in the state of Missouri, as shown in the certificate from the Missouri Secretary of State, attached as Exhibit 1 hereto.

4. Applicant hereby requests certificates of service authority to provide interexchange private line and nonswitched local telecommunications services, including the resale thereof, within the state of Missouri pursuant to §§ 392.410, 392.420, and 392.430 RSMo.

Applicant may already possess the interexchange authority requested herein, but because of the uncertainty in this regard, and out of an abundance of caution with respect to having the appropriate operating authorities, submits this Application. Applicant has immediate plans to supply optical fiber to schools, and connecting schools with one another, and therefore submits this Application.

- 5. Applicant hereby requests that these services be classified as competitive services pursuant to § 392.361 RSMo. Applicant initially intends to provide fiber capacity and services on fiber facilities to other carriers and to end users, specifically including public and private schools and school districts.
- 6. Applicant hereby requests, pursuant to § 392.420, 392.361 RSMo, competitive classifications of its interexchange private line and nonswitched local services. Applicant states that interexchange private line services and nonswitched local services are sufficiently competitive to justify a lesser degree of regulation. Applicant is not requesting classification as a competitive or transitionally competitive company. Applicant requests that the Commission notify all telecommunications companies as provided in § 392.361 RSMo.
- 7. For the services intitially proposed to be offered, as set forth in the tariffs attached hereto, Applicant requests waiver of the following Commission rules:

tariffs filed herewith, together with such other and further relief that the Commission deems appropriate.
