

I should also note that there is substantial debate in the revenue requirement
 testimony filed by intervening parties about the correct estimate of margins associated with
 off-system sales. For example, in his non-proprietary testimony for Missouri Industrial
 Energy Consumers, Mr. Dauphinais estimates that the Company's margin estimate of \$183
 million is too low by about \$30.5 million.

As with the FAC, AARP opposes the sharing mechanism proposed by AmerenUE
to treat off-system sales as unfair to consumers. However, later in my testimony I will
describe modifications to the margin-sharing structure that would make it more equitable,
assuming there is interest in adopting a mechanism like this and coupling it with any FAC
that the Commission might approve.
