## OPC, MECG, Staff proposal regarding EDR availability provisions

Customers receiving service under another rate schedule with the Economic Development RiderSchedule <u>PED</u> and requesting service under Schedule MKT shall make such requestmigrate to Schedule MKT within two (2) years of taking service under the <u>Schedule PEDEconomic Development Rider</u> or prior to that Customer's average monthly peak load exceeding 50MW. If the Customer remains on the <u>Schedule PEDEconomic Development Rider</u> after it exceeds two (2) years or 50MW, before being allowed to request service undermigrated to Schedule MKT, the Customer must take service under a standard, otherwise applicable rate schedule for a period of time equal to the time that the Customer took service under the <u>Schedule PEDEconomic Development Rider</u> after it exceeded two (2) years or 50MW.

For a period of five years from the effective date of the first Special High-Load Factor Market Rate Contract. Schedule MKT shall be limited to the lesser of three (3) customers or 500MW, at which point the impact of this Schedule MKT on non-MKT customers, including the Schedule PED discounts, shall be analyzed before any additional customers may be included.
