## AMENDMENT TO APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

Comes now Infonet Telecommunications Corporation ("Infonet") and for its Amendment to Application for Certificate of Service Authority states to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") as follows:

- 1. On March 25, 2002, Infonet filed an Application for a Certificate of Authority to provide resold interexchange telecommunications services and to classify the services and the company as competitive. Infonet filed a tariff with the application with a forty-five day effective date.
- 2. It has been brought to the company's attention that in order to provide the services listed in the tariff, Infonet should also have a certificate of authority to provide local exchange telecommunications services.
- 3. Infonet agrees that if granted local exchange authority, such authority will be limited to the provisioning of dedicated, nonswitched local exchange private line service.
- 4. All other information in the original Application remains unchanged and this request for nonswitched local exchange authority is the only change to the original application. Infonet does not propose any change to the tariff filed with the original application except that the

company has voluntarily extended the effective date of the tariff for thirty days to June 8, 2002.

Wherefore, Infonet respectfully requests that the Commission accept this amendment to its application for a certificate of service authority and grant it a certificate of local exchange authority, nonswitched, as well as the intrastate, interexchange authority previously sought as well as any other relief appropriate in the circumstances.
