NOTICE OF FINDING OF NECESSITY

The Commission is opening this file to amend the existing rule that imposes reporting requirements on electric utilities and rural electric cooperatives. The amendment will require electric utilities and rural electric cooperatives to inform the Commission of accidents and events involving stray voltage within areas where the utility or cooperative supplies electricity, even if the utility or cooperative believes that the voltage originated from the customer's side of the meter. The Commission finds that the subject rules are necessary so that the Commission will be informed about serious accidents or events involving power supplied by electric utilities and rural electric cooperatives.

The Commission will seek comments from interested persons as to whether the rules are appropriate and properly designed and written.
