## PUBLIC FIRE SERVICES

MISSOURI

Public Service Commission

1. On and after February 1, 1970, no charge will be made to the City of Jefferson for rental on public fire hydrants (House Bill No. 241, 75th General Assembly of Missouri Legislature).
2. Installation of public fire hydrants after February 1, 1970.
  - (a) In the event that the City of Jefferson by ordinance or otherwise, shall order the installation of additional public fire hydrants on existing mains having an internal diameter of six inches or larger the Company will install such hydrants at the cost of the Company and will be maintained by and at the expense of the Company.
  - (b) Where pipeline installations are required to carry out an order of the City of Jefferson, to install public fire hydrants, where existing mains in the opinion of the Company are inadequate to provide fire flows to such hydrants, the Company will install such mains at the cost of the City of Jefferson and will install such hydrants at the cost of the Company and will be maintained by and at the expense of the Company.
  - (c) Whenever a change in the location of a public fire hydrant is ordered or requested by the City of Jefferson or made necessary due to a change by the City of Jefferson in line or grade of any roadway, street, avenue, alley, bridge, curb or walk or public place, such change will be made by the Company and the cost of such change will be paid one-half (1/2) by the Company and one-half (1/2) by the City of Jefferson, under the provisions of Ordinance No. 8036 approved July 1, 1968.

- (d) Whenever a relocation of a public fire hydrant is ordered or requested by a person other than the City of Jefferson, said relocation will be made by the Company at the expense of the person ordering, requesting or making necessary such relocation. Any relocation of public fire hydrants must be approved by the City of Jefferson.
- (e) Prior to any relocation of public fire hydrants the applicant for the relocation of said public fire hydrants shall pay to the Company an amount estimated by the Company to be the cost of the relocation of said public fire hydrants. Said payment shall be adjusted to the actual cost of the relocation as soon as possible after the work is completed.
- (f) When extension of the Company's water mains are made in accordance with Exhibit "A" of rules and regulations governing water main extensions, necessary public fire hydrants with accessories will be installed and the cost thereof shall be included in the cost of the main extensions covered under said Exhibit "A".
- (g) All public fire hydrants shall become the property of the Company and shall be maintained by the Company.
- (h) No person except for the legitimate purpose of extinguishing fires, shall open any public fire hydrant without the consent of the Company.

- (i) The use of public fire hydrants will be restricted to the taking of water for the extinguishing of fires and water shall not be taken from any public fire hydrant for construction purposes, sprinkling streets, flushing sewers or gutters, or for any other use unless specifically permitted by the Company for the particular time and occasion.
- (j) During freezing weather, the City shall notify the Company after it has opened any hydrant.
- (k) Inspections and tests of public fire hydrants will be made by the Company at convenient times and reasonable intervals.
