**ORDER DENYING SECOND MOTION
FOR RECONSIDERATION**

Issue Date: May 24, 2011

Effective Date: May 25, 2011

On May 4, 2011, the Commission issued an order approving interim rates, effective on May 25. On May 11, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers (MIEC) filed a motion for reconsideration. Noting that MIEC failed to set forth grounds on how the order was unlawful, unjust or unreasonable, the Commission denied the motion.

Expounding on why it believes the Commission's order is unlawful, MIEC filed a second motion for reconsideration. Having considered the arguments set out in the second motion, the Commission finds that MIEC has not shown that the Commission's order is in violation of the relevant law: Section 386.266, RSMo (Cum Supp 2010), and Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.090.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers' second motion for reconsideration is denied.

2. This order shall become effective on May 25, 2011.
