## ORDER GRANTING PETITION FOR ADMISSION PRO HAC VICE

The Missouri Public Service Commission is granting the *Petition for Leave to Appear Pro Hac Vice* ("motion"). Counsel for Sierra Club, Earth Island Institute d/b/a Renew Missouri, and National Resources Defense Council filed the motion on August 2, 2012. No party filed a response within the time allowed by regulation.<sup>1</sup>

The motion seeks an order granting "leave to appear in" this action. Such representation constitutes the practice of law, which is subject to the exclusive governance of the Missouri Supreme Court. The Missouri Supreme Court requires executive branch agencies to police the court's determinations, which the Commission does through 4 CSR 240-2.040(3)(C), which tracks Missouri Supreme Court Rule 9.03.
